

Lifetime Empowerment Award



Michael Williamson

Michael Williamson is the third-generation owner of Williamson Funeral Home in Niagara Falls—the city's first and only Black-owned funeral home. He began working in the family business at age 12 and has upheld a legacy of compassionate service and excellence. A leader in both business and faith, he serves as Chair of the Deacon Board at New Hope Baptist Church and as a council member of the Niagara Area Foundation. His life is defined by purpose, family, and dedication to community.



Kenneth & Sharon Holley

Kenneth and Sharon Holley are the co-founders of Zawadi Books, one of the longest-standing Black-owned bookstores in the nation. Since 1976, they've created a space for culture, learning, and representation in Buffalo's Black community. Sharon, a master storyteller and retired librarian, and Kenneth, a veteran and community advocate, have built a legacy of literacy, empowerment, and cultural pride for nearly five decades.

Shelden Gibbs

At just 19, Shelden Gibbs is the founder and CEO of Classic Knot, a handcrafted bow tie brand he launched at age 10. A graduate of Nichols School and now a student at Canisius College, Shelden has been featured in news outlets across New York for his leadership and creativity. 


Dennis Wilson Jr.

Dennis Wilson Jr. is a multifaceted entrepreneur, educator, and community advocate based in Buffalo, NY. He is the co-owner of The Oakk Room, one of Buffalo's premier Black-owned establishments and a cornerstone for community, culture, and connection. In addition to his work at The Oakk Room, Dennis leads a graphic design firm and an event promotion company, while also serving as a high school teacher in Buffalo Public Schools.

His impact extends beyond business—Dennis has used his platforms to empower, mentor, and invest in the next generation of leaders. This award honors his legacy by recognizing young people who are building their own paths while lifting others along the way.

At just 13 years old, Donald Pettiway III launched Lawn Barber Lawncare & Landscape with a single push mower and a bold vision. Using a bike and trailer, he began servicing lawns in his neighborhood, quickly gaining a reputation for being reliable, professional, and community-minded. He took pride in helping elderly and disabled residents maintain their homes with dignity.

When his motorized bike was stolen, Donald didn't give up—instead, he leaned on community support, started a GoFundMe, and used the momentum to bounce back even stronger. Now operating with a truck, full equipment, and an expanding team, Donald offers services from lawn maintenance and landscaping to surface washing and tree trimming.

More than just a business owner, Donald is a role model to his peers and younger brother. He leads with humility, consistency, and character, and continues to dream big—working toward a future in civil engineering where he can blend business and design for greater impact.

Saints and Friends, LLC


